All are welcome.

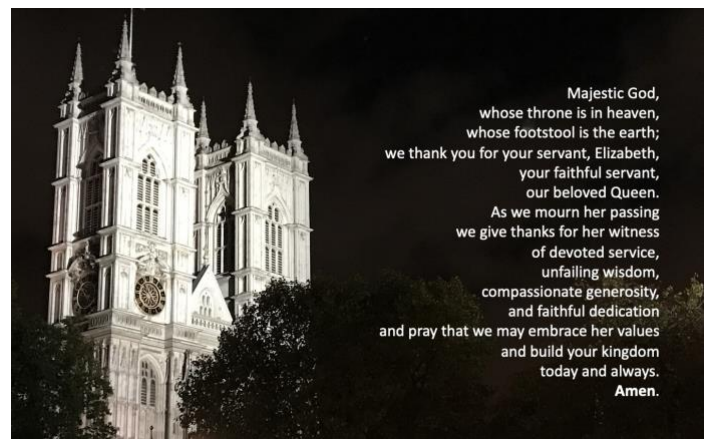


Remembering our Queen.
