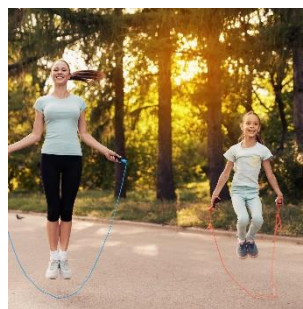
## Welcome to the beginning of March Newsletter.

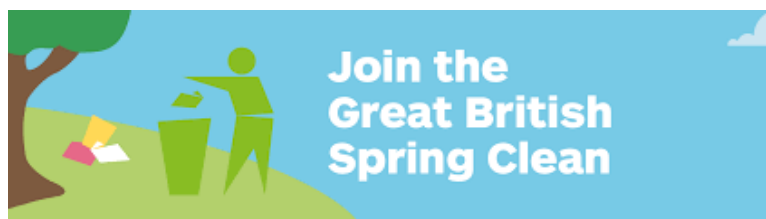
