Physical Education: To improve the quality of Teaching and Learning in physical education

Objective

To maintain teaching staff expertise and develop confidence in the teaching of PE.

Actions:

- PE subject leader to work alongside teaching staff and deliver demonstration lessons.
- Use of specialist sports coaches (mini-kicks) to deliver aspects of the PE curriculum – REAL PE.
- For staff to engage with CPD opportunities.

Projected Outcomes

- Staff will have accessed support from specialist sports coaches to aide in their delivery of PE lessons.

Healthy Active Lifestyles: Ensuring all our children have access to regular exercise.

Objective

Ensuring all our children have access to regular exercise and understand the importance of a healthy lifestyle.

Actions:

- Playground leaders training in KS1 and KS2.
- Daily coach led football skill sessions

Projected Outcomes

- Playground leaders are effective in their role.
- Children are actively making healthy choices.

Competitive School Sport: Increasing pupil's participation in extra-curricular sport.

Objective

To increase the opportunities for children to take part in competitive sporting activities/festivals.

Actions:

- Compete in a full range of 'pyramid events calendar events.

Projected Outcomes

- A higher percentage of children participate in competitive events.
- Gifted and talented children will have the opportunity to compete local/regional level.

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- Opportunities to enter and compete in local and other pyramid competitions.
- Engage in virtual inter-school competitions for multi-skill events.
